

Sandblasting



Sandblasting glass blocks is a design choice.

Sandblasting is a process where an aluminum grit is fired at the glass to remove the top layer. By stripping the surface of glass removes the gloss finish of the glass block and creates a beautiful matt appearance.

Sandblasting increases opacity of glass blocks and if using lighting, it enriches the visual appearance by absorbing the light and equally distributing the glow.

Also, as picture opposite demonstrates, when sunlight shines through on to a patterned block it accentuates the pattern.
